CDA Bid Opportunity - Remote Transmitter and Receiver-R

The City of Chicago, Department of Aviation, has issued an Addendum for the following project:

Description:

The Work generally includes but is not limited to: (i) the preparation and improvement of the site; (ii) construction of a 1,265 square foot block building on continuous strip footings with a wood roof truss system; (iii) installation of electrical, mechanical, and telecommunications systems inside of the building; (iv) the design and erection of four (4-ea) sixty foot (60-ft) high antennas, to include foundations, with appurtenances; (v) construction of approximately 2,700 linear feet of new direct buried CED/FAA duct bank, 530 linear feet of bored and jacked duct bank and 178 linear feet of 36" diameter supported steel casing for routing of the fiber optic transmission line (FOTS) across the Interim Bensenville Ditch (fiber optic cable to be installed by others), and, (vi) preparation of the FOTS loop infrastructure to receive FOTS cable including investigation of existing FOTS infrastructure condition, remediation work as required, cleaning and mandreling conduit, visibly marking conduits reserved for FAA use with tags or paint, and placing of pull ropes.
